- Please make sure your child is prepared by having them wear sneakers, clothes for play, and sunscreen. The Wildcat Athletic Club plans to give out bottled water for each student. If your child plans to bring in a water bottle, please make sure their name is clearly written on the bottle.
- This year's theme is the USA. Students will be asked to wear their class shirts but we would love if all the students (and even parents) could incorporate red, white, and blue into their outfit to help celebrate our great country!
- A reminder of the field event times for each class is listed below.
- When arriving to Field Day, parking may be an issue. Please carpool or walk if possible. The entrance to the back field for Field Day will be on the south side of the building near the playground.
