Earn prizes beginning Monday, June 30 – Friday, August 22.

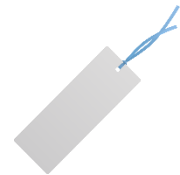

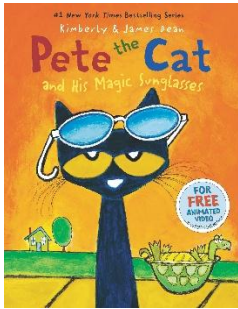


Cooking Up Love for Dad, Ages 3 years-Grade 5 with a parent/caregiver

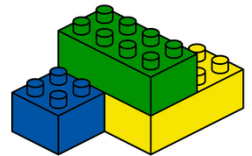
